Free Skill Building Resources:

Explore over [300 short lessons](#) which support learners to develop their skills. There are also [workbooks](#) and [workshops](#) aimed at older learners which help think about the development of skills.

The [Homezone](#) – **best suited for year 7 and 8**: get involved in your child's skills development by asking them to login to Homezone. They can complete a weekly skill challenge or select modules to work through at a specific level.

[Benchmark](#) and [Launchpad](#) – allow students to self-assess their skills and then develop them through self-led modules on Launchpad. Best used by learners 14+.
